December 2010 Criteria Information Sheet

Please provide information using the following 4 required criteria listed below. Your submission package needs to include specific details about your project. (Think of this a résumé for your project)

1. Provide a description of the project in terms of its location within the community and suitability for its market. Include how its layout, building design and special features enhance its overall market appeal, as well as contribute to the project's value, design, or usefulness.
2. Challenges faced by the builder, designer, and/or developer with regards to budget, time constraints, construction, environmental and regulatory issues, etc.
3. Include information on the success of the project in terms of leasing or selling, owner satisfaction, financial return, etc.
4. Submit your package as a "resume" for the project. Example: Descriptions of the project, color photos, details specific to your project, etc.

All 4 required criteria must be addressed completely, to be considered by the nominating committee.
